

# Rules for Personal Watercraft (PWC) and Other Motorized Vessels

## *PWCs are allowed on 95% of Lakes Mead and Mohave*

### Lake Mead National Recreation Area

**Muddy River In-Flow Area**  
(Semi-Primitive Zoning)  
PWCs not allowed. All boats must operate at flat-wake speed.

**Virgin River In-Flow Area**  
(Primitive Zoning)  
PWCs not allowed. Only boats with electric trolling motors and operating at flat-wake speed are allowed.

**Grand Wash Bay**  
(Semi-Primitive Zoning)  
PWCs not allowed. All boats must operate at flat-wake speed.

**Gypsum Bay**  
(Primitive Zoning)  
PWCs not allowed. Only boats with electric trolling motors and operating at flat-wake speed are allowed.

**GRAND CANYON NATIONAL PARK**

*PWCs not allowed in Grand Canyon*

Lake Mead/Grand Canyon boundary

**Bonelli Bay**  
(Semi-Primitive Zoning)  
PWCs not allowed. All boats must operate at flat-wake speed.

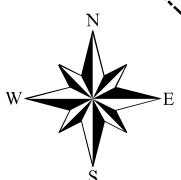
### Shoreline Safety

A 200-foot flat wake zone around beaches with bathers, around boats at the shoreline, and persons in the water or at the shoreline is in effect for safety reasons.

**Upper Black Canyon Boating Rules**  
(Upstream from Willow Beach Harbor to Hoover Dam)  
**Year Round**  
Sunday and Monday  
(Primitive Zoning)  
Motorized vessels prohibited  
**Labor Day - Memorial Day**  
Tuesday - Saturday  
(Semi-primitive Zoning)  
Motors greater than 65 HP prohibited  
PWCs prohibited  
**Memorial Day - Labor Day**  
Tuesday - Saturday  
No horsepower restrictions  
PWCs allowed
